- ◆ Exceptional customer service skills, including the ability to establish/maintain successful relationships with the students, parents, and educational community.
- ◆ Must be ready, willing and able to participate in all indoor and outdoor activities and lift, carry, move or otherwise assist with children or equipment as required.
- ◆ Must be able to negotiate all types of terrain and other physical space, and all types of weather, temperature and environmental factors in order to participate in all indoor and outdoor activities.
