About the NJ American Rescue Plan (ARP) Stabilization Grant:

This grant provides financial relief to licensed child care providers and registered family child care providers to support key operating expenses. Providers may use the grant for wages and benefits, insurance, rent, mortgage, utilities, cleaning and sanitizing, professional development related to health and safety, mental health services, and other operational expenses to remain open and operating. These non-competitive grants provide up to \$80,000 for licensed child care providers (depending on license capacity and estimated monthly expenses) and a \$2,000 payment for family child care providers, issued in the first payment installment.
