RE: School-Age Tuition Assistance Program Extension through February 2021

Dear Parent:

You are receiving this letter because you submitted an application for the Department of Human Services, Division of Family Development (DHS/DFD) COVID-19 School-Age Tuition Assistance Program (CCTAP). If you have been approved and your child (5-13 years old) is enrolled with an eligible licensed center or registered family child care provider for child care while remotely learning, you are eligible to receive an additional month of assistance, ending on February 28, 2021.

The one-month extension will happen automatically. You do not have to do anything if your child remains with their current provider. If child care is not needed for February, or you are switching providers, please email us immediately at NJCOVID19APPS@dhs.nj.gov, and let us know what you have decided. Please remember to include your Application ID number (which can be found on the auto-generated emails you received from the application system email address: noreply@childcarenj.gov).

This extension was possible due to federal Coronavirus Relief Funds. The newly signed federal legislation extends the January deadline, providing us an opportunity to extend the program through February 28, 2021.
